

## Introduction / Intermediate to Premiere Professional - 2 Days



Adobe Premiere enables nonlinear video editing. The powerful real-time video and audio editing tools give you precise control over virtually every aspect of your production.

This course explores most of the Package in some detail and aims to bring the client to the level where he or she can setup, edit, export and manage a Premiere Pro project with a reasonable degree of confidence. Emphasis is given to those areas in the program where there are potential traps, allowing the user a good level of self-support.

Students do not need any experience in using Adobe Premiere.
